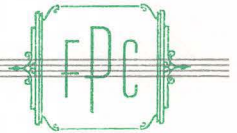

Dear Sir:

Please refer to your letter of February 7, 1964.

It was our distinct understanding from Mr. Adams in Morehead City on Tuesday, January 14, 1964 that he had only a half day's work or less at the Carteret County courthouse in connection with our contractual agreement with you. The Planning Board meeting was the night before on Monday, January 13th which was the same day he left Miami. As far as we were concerned, he was entirely free Tuesday to complete his work in the Courthouse and return to Miami. We provided a rental car for Mr. Adams and arranged that he could turn this car in at the airport in New Bern, North Carolina from where his plane was scheduled to depart Tuesday evening.

If the work which needed to be done under our contract with you amounted to more than that described above, then we feel that we not only should not be charged for the extra day's time but that the contract price should bear at least one-half of the plane fare round trip.

Last night, the Planning Board met again in Carteret County and turned down our proposal with your plans completely, which means that this effort was made in vain. On two occasions, I have asked Mr. Calender to review the contract price with you since the acreage involved was less than one-third of that anticipated and advise us as to whether the contract price remains a fair charge in his opinion. In any event, we would appreciate your pushing the contract job to its completion as the only portion of the work done which can mean anything to us now is the appraisal with which you have yet to furnish us.
