

Seashore Bill Signed by President Ford

THE LANGUAGE of the amendment concerning acquisition of defined park lands follows:

"Lands owned by the State" of North Carolina or any political subdivision thereof may be acquired only by donation, but the Secretary, may . . . acquire any other non-Federal lands, marshlands, waters, or interests therein which are located within the boundaries of the seashore by donation, purchase with donated or appropriated funds, or exchange . . ."

The bill President Ford signed was an omnibus National Park Seashore bill (PL93-477) which provides \$7.635.000 in "new funds." The other money, the difference between that figure and \$7,903,000, was in the 1966 bill. (See Page 9-B this issue for related story.)
