Bermuda? The Canary Islands? None of these, but Cape Lookout, North Carolina. So near in time and space, yet a world away for those seeking to relax in the calm beauty of a truly unique vacation spot.

For a weekend or weeks on end —within easy reach.

Located at the southern tip of Core Banks, Cape Lookout is washed on the east and west by the Atlantic Ocean. The Gulf Stream is just a few miles east of the Cape, three hours nearer than the trip from the mainland to there, making it an ideal jumping off point for gulfstream fishing that has earned for this part of North Carolina's coast the title "Gamefish Junction." A third of the nation's population lies within 500 miles of Cape Lookout. But the absence of bridges to the Cape makes it your own private vacation paradise. A dock on the protected inland side awaits your boat, a light plane can land on the natural landing strip that lies along the east side of the Cape. In the spring, summer, and fall months a private ferry makes regular runs from the mainland.

The Beach Club

To insure that your vacation on Cape Lookout will be all that you want and more, the private Cape Lookout Beach Club is being formed. The club, limited to 500 members, will start with charter members chosen from those people considered to be leaders in their home communities. The proposed articles of agreement establishing this club are enclosed.

Building the Beach Club

The club will be located on the inland side of the Cape facing the protected waters of Barden's Cut, allowing easy access to the ocean without crossing a bar or an inlet. Cabanas of the club will be of a rustic Caribbean design, reminiscent of southern waters. Yet the interior of these cabanas will be furnished to provide the utmost in comfort, compatible with the relaxed mood of a beach vacation. The club itself will be operated by its own members through a governing committee elected by these members.




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


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
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What the Club Offers You
